



## Ways to Serve Your School

The following are just a few ways you can volunteer at the school.

- Ask the principal for work projects your church could accomplish.
- Recruit tutors or mentors from your church and the community.
- Create a Teacher Appreciation Day. Provide food in the teachers' lounge and have the church sign thank you cards to all the teachers.
- Provide cookies or a deli tray during Teacher Orientation at the beginning of the school year.
- Organize a day to pick up trash in and around the school.
- Organize a canned food or Toys for Tots drive.
- Pray for God's creativity in serving your school.
- Offer your services as an assistant coach (or coach's assistant) for athletic programs in which you have some experience.
- Be available to fill support roles at various events and competitions. For example, it takes an army of helpers to run a track meet. The host school needs people to do everything from holding measuring tapes to setting up hurdles that have been knocked down.
- Be a judge for speech tournaments.
- Set up a periodic (weekly, monthly, quarterly) breakfast for students if your church is near the campus.
- Basically, be willing—as a member of the community—to offer your skills to your school.
